The Credit Valley Hospital is a professional, caring, health care organization that promotes life, health and innovation. Credit Valley is known for its innovative, can-do approach to providing quality patient care to the people of Mississauga and the surrounding region (approximately one million people).

Clinical service programs include: general medicine, surgery, renal, oncology, emergency, mental health, complex continuing care, rehabilitation, obstetrics and gynaecology, paediatrics and cardiac services as well as regional programs in clinical genetics, renal, maternal child care and oncology.

The Credit Valley Hospital has consistently met Accreditation Canada's national safety and patient care standards. Credit Valley is also a provincial leader in reducing ER wait times.

A 330,000 square foot expansion to house the Carlo Fidani Peel Regional Cancer Centre and the Vijay Jeet and Neena Kanwar Ambulatory Care Centre opened in June 2005.

In June, 2008 the hospital began construction of the second phase of its expansion project to provide an additional 270,000 square feet and 70,000 renovated space to accommodate:

- A new four storey inpatient unit (A wing)
- A two storey/three level addition on the north side of the hospital (H wing)
- Increasing capacity from 392 to 439 beds
- Doubling the number of birthing suites from seven to 15 and adding two new operative delivery suites
- An expansion of our level two and neonatal intensive care unit from 22 to 37 to facilitate care for pre-term and other newborns requiring specialized neonatal care
- Expanded laboratory from 15,000 to 42,000 square feet

This phase II expansion is slated for completion in Spring 2011.

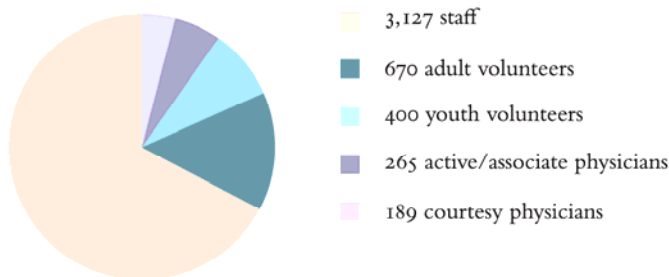
In June 2010, the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care announced funding to plan for phase III which includes restructuring and renovations for expansion of operating rooms and surgical support areas.

Mississauga Academy of Medicine:

In February of 2006, the MOHLTC and the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities announced a plan to create an I Academy of Medicine at University of Toronto Mississauga involving the Credit Valley Hospital and Trillium Health Centre. The Mississauga Academy of Medicine is officially scheduled to open in September 2011. Credit Valley will provide training at both the undergraduate and post graduate level. 54 undergraduate students will formally begin their studies at the new Academy with 27 training at each hospital. The University of Toronto is establishing this Academy to increase the number of medical students and ultimately the number of doctors to serve the growing population. In addition to the Academy, Credit Valley is also developing a comprehensive residency program, the first step being the establishment of the Credit Valley Family Medicine Teaching Unit in July 2006.
